Act now to avoid huge increases in business rates



If you are like Avon Valley, your business rates could be marked for a 300% increase next year! It's all because HMRC is looking to standardise how rates are calculated across this industry.

NFAN has set up a sub-committee to help tackle this problem and we've been advised Farm Attractions need to check and challenge their valuations before February 2020 or HMRC may assume everyone is happy with them.

The more challenges we make as a sector, the louder voice we will have at finding a better solution with HMRC.

What to do:

STEP 1

Log on to HMRC's payment gateway (or ask your accountant to do this for you) and request the detailed valuation.

STEP 2

If you disagree with the valuation, challenge it via the gateway.

BEWARE: If your new Ratable Value has been calculated by using a percentage of turnover method (typically between 6% and 12%), NFAN strongly recommend that you seek professional assistance. Contact us if you need any assistance.

rare-breed eco-farm in
Buckinghamshire featuring a
wide array of animals has
recently been launched to
the market for sale for £1.3
million, after founder Ray
Marzec decided to sell up.



Green Dragon eco-farm

Ray had wanted to open an eco-farm after watching a news report on the Rare Breeds Survival Trust back in the 1970s when he was a teenager.

The dream became a reality when he bought the 43-acre farm in 2002, and set about converting three of the old barns into homes to fund the enterprise.

His partner, Lesley Maddox, joined the project in 2013 and with her help, Ray's vision to create an environmentally-

friendly 'eco-farm' came true in October 2014, when the farm's Eco Centre opened to the public.

Since then, they have been joined by exotic pets and native wildlife that include Eurasian Lynx, reindeer, wallabies, chameleons, owls and red squirrels, attracting thousands of visitors each year.

Ray said: "Whoever buys this farm, their life will change, and change for the

better. This is an amazing opportunity for someone with plenty of ambition.

"I really hope the buyer will keep the farm as a going concern - this was my dream for a long time and I'd love to see the farm run with the same kind of passion in the future.

Since launching the property to market, Ray has also secured planning permission to build a four-bedroom bungalow on the site, making the property more attractive to buyers.
