

Disabled facilities making huge impact at Park Hall

Park Hall in Oswestry were so inspired by the new Changing Places disabled toilet at Longdown Activity Farm that they finally achieved their aim of installing their own facility.

Richard Powell, Owner of Park Hall said "Obviously it would have been really helpful to secure grant funding however we feel installing a changing places facility was well worth the extra £8k it cost rather an installing a conventional disabled toilet. The response from both our visitors and local people has been amazing!"
